eBay Volunteer

We use eBay as an extra outlet for goods donated to our charity shops. You will be using eBay to research the price and availability of items already for sale, photographing items to sell, uploading information about goods for sale onto the eBay site and then packing and posting sold items. We aim to maintain excellent standards of customer service and your role will contribute to this. You will also help to maintain a clean, tidy and safe working environment.



Online Fashion Volunteer

You will help to source the right stock from our existing charity shops and will present the stock in a commercially sound manner in order to maximise sales. Your role will be to steer the shop teams to be aware of 'what's hot and what's not', so a great knowledge of current fashion is required.

Upcycling Volunteer

This role would be ideally suited to someone who is currently studying fashion or textiles at University or College and is seeking work experience in the market. Alternatively, someone who has a keen eye for fashion and who is able to sew.

Shop Assistant Volunteer

You will be behind the scenes sorting and pricing stock or in the shop helping to display goods for sale and serving customers.

We have shops in Huddersfield (Almondbury, Lindley, Golcar or Manchester Road), Halifax (King Cross), Brighouse, Heckmondwike, Holmfirth and Hebden Bridge.
